## *AIDS Specialist Speaks With Science Students*

Thomas Gegeny, executive director for the Center for AIDS (CFA) in Houston, Texas, recently spoke to Newtown High School students in Frank LaBanca's science class about the ongoing research taking place in the continued search for a cure for the disease. The CFA is a community based, nonprofit organization specializing in HIV treatment, research information, and advocacy.
